Public Services: D. Morrow met Nov. 27, 2023 at 5:30 p.m.

The November meeting of the Division of Utilities was called to order on the 27<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 p.m. Utilities Director John Geller first discussed well #10. The order has been released to the pump manufacturing. Hope to take delivery by the end of January – First of February 2024. The front steps at the water plant were installed in 1998, has been replaced. The distribution crew has been turning on all main line valves. This is done annually. Meters usually last 10 years.

Wastewater: A meeting on the 208 plan was held. 5 departments were invited. Heath Hills and future development needs sewer consideration. The ATS has been moved back to the middle of December. Following a review of funds, the council entered into executive session to consider the employment of a public employee at 6:14 p.m. coming out of executive session at 6:46 p.m. and back on the record. The meeting adjourned 6:46 p.m. Next month there will be no Public Service Meeting. Our next Public Service Meeting will be Jan. 29, 2023 at 5:30 p.m.

Public Safety: A. Porter will meet Dec. 18, 2023 at 5:30 p.m.

Streets & Drainage: J. Roberts met this evening at 5:40 p.m.

Thank you, Paul for managing this meeting. I will refer to Paul Moretti for the report this evening.

On the agenda this evening there was a Q & A about possible storm water utilities. The new building at the street department has all permits completed. We look to see the contractor starting in the next month. Lastly, our trucks are ready to snow plow but hoping for a mild winter. The meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.

- 1). Vandalism in Geller Park Graffiti in the park about two weeks ago- writing #44 and free Judy on everything. Cleaned everything up that Monday and the next day it was done again. They saw two kids in the park and asked them if they did it and they no, so they asked them to stay and talk to the police. They started running. When the police separated them one of them confessed. May have to replace Vietnam Memorial. They are still trying to clean new pads purchased for disc golf. The city will seek damages.
- 2). Agreement between The City of Heath and HSYAA in progress —
  The agreement has been finalized and signed by the mayor. Mitch will contact Chade
  Hartley to get their approval. The city will not allow any charging of fees to enter the park
  And HYSAA will need to be responsible for dumping trash on weekends.
- 3). <u>Disc Golf</u> We had a warm day before Thanksgiving and it was packed. We have a total Investment of about \$7,000 and it is really being utilized.
