City of Heath Civil Service Commission is posting the opening for a Police Officer for the City of Heath.

The posting is both Lateral Transfer eligible or civil service testing. FrontLine National testing is required for the civil service list.

Job Summary

Will support the Mission and Value Statement of the Heath Police Department. The officer will develop expertise of state and local laws and ordinances, will enforce traffic laws and investigate traffic accidents; responds to calls for service; investigate reports of crime against persons or property; patrol the city in effort to reduce criminal activity; perform lawful arrests in the performance of duty; will investigate juvenile complaints and observe and record unusual activity; complete reports relating to criminal offenses and missing persons; is responsible for serving warrants and subpoenas as necessary; investigate active alarms; prepares written criminal cases for prosecution; will be prepared to testify to the facts of cases investigated; performs ancillary duties that support department operations. This list should not be considered exhaustive.

Qualifications

The applicant is not required to have OPOTA certification. Those with OPOTA certification earn bonus points. Applicants without OPOTA certification must successfully complete and receive OPOTA certification within six months of employment. Applicants must pass the NTN test and physical agility test, be at least 21 years of age, have 20/20 vision or correctable to 20/20 in both eyes; must possess a valid Ohio driver's license; have good command of English language and ability to communicate; must have ability to work with the general public, possess highest professional and ethical standards, think quickly and clearly under stressful situations, follow department procedures for investigation and enforcement of local and state laws. Ability to work varied hours and shifts including evenings, weekends, holidays and rotating shifts. MUST NOT have any felonies or misdemeanor offences of violence. The Heath Police Department adheres to a strict tattoo/piercing policy.

Lateral Entry

Lateral Entry candidates will be considered meeting the following criteria:

- a) Must have two (2) years full-time experience or five (5) years part-time experience, or equivalent combination as determined by the Mayor (Safety Director) and Police Chief.
- b) Must pass a physical agility test, must pass a successful background investigation including, but not limited to: a) Physical, b) Psychological evaluation, c) Polygraph/CVSA.

Application Instructions

Two applications need to be filed; one with the City of Heath and the other with the National Testing Network. The City of Heath applications may be obtained on line at www.heathohio.gov. The application along with copies of a valid Driver's license, and relevant certifications must be turned in to the City of Heath, 1287 Hebron Road, Heath, Ohio 43056. If extra credit for military service is desired, a copy of your DD214 Form must also be attached to the application.

The other application filed is with the National Testing Network.

Both applications and testing will be available July 7, 2020 – August 13, 2020. All applications and testing results must be received by the City of Heath no later than 4:30 pm, August 13, 2020.

Selection Process:

- 1.) Review of minimum qualifications
- 2.) National Police Officer Selection Test (NTN)
- 3.) A physical fitness test must be passed
- 4.) Civil Service adds necessary extra credit to NTN scores and agility test, prepares list and posts
- 5.) City of Heath schedules interviews
- 6.) Background investigation/CVSA
- 7.) Job offer made contingent on passing physical, psychological and drug testing.
