Deadline for applications both to the City of Heath and to C-Tec for the CPAT test is May 31, 2017.

Job Summary

Candidates perform under the supervision of the Fire Chief, Captain, and/or Lieutenant and are responsible for responding to fire and other medical and non-medical emergencies to protect life and property under the guidelines established by the City of Heath Fire Department. Candidate is required to participate in emergency medical, firefighting, haz-mat, station and equipment maintenance, fire prevention activities, and perform any other duties related to the department as assigned. May be required to acquire fire inspector certification.

Qualifications

Must be at least 18 years of age. High school diploma or G.E.D. equivalent. Must possess and maintain a valid Ohio driver's license as a condition of employment. Must pass CPAT written and physical tests. Must have medic certification at time of hire, must successfully complete Ohio Police and Fire Retirement Disability Fund physical certification and psychological testing, and any collective bargaining agreements as required. The candidate must pass a yearly fitness test as a condition of continual employment.

Application Instructions

Two applications need to be filed; one with the City of Heath and the other with C-Tec for the CPAT exam.

The City of Heath applications may be obtained on line at www.heathohio.gov. The application along with copies of a valid Driver's license, and relevant certifications must be turned in to the City of Heath, 1287

Hebron Road, Heath, Ohio 43056. If extra credit for military service is desired, a copy of your DD214 Form must also be attached to the application.

The other application filed is with the Central Ohio Firefighter Testing Consortium, through C-Tec's Adult Educational Program, www.c-tec.edu. Deadline for this application and fee submission is May 31, 2017.

Selection Process:

- 1.) Review of minimum qualifications
- 2.) CPAT testing (written and physical)
- 3.) Civil Service adds necessary extra credit to CPAT scores, prepares list and posts
- 4.) City of Heath schedules interviews
- 5.) Background check processed
- 6.) Job offer made contingent on passing OP & F physical requirements and psychological testing
