Street Worker I Examination

The City of Heath Civil Service Commission will conduct an examination for the position of Street Worker I on Wednesday, April 3, 2019 at Hoback Park Shelter House, 60 Dorsey Mill Rd. Heath, Ohio at 6:30 p.m.

This individual will carry out any laboring duties connected with the Street Department and assist with repairs of equipment. Typical tasks include: plow snow; maintenance and repair of all City streets; general housekeeping and maintenance of Street Dept. Buildings and Grounds; maintains and operates equipment; carries out any other duties designated by the Street Worker III/Foreman or Street Superintendent.

Employment standards for this position include: must be a high school graduate or equivalent; two years' experience in general street maintenance preferred but not required; must have the ability to work well with fellow employees; must be able to receive a valid Ohio CDL B – general, air brake and tank within six months; must be able to operate machinery including front-end loader, etc.; may require exposure to chemicals, solvents, pesticides and air borne pathogens; may be required to attend classes/seminars.

Current salary range is \$33,043.37 - \$36,081.70 based on experience. The City of Heath offers a competitive benefit package which includes Ohio Public Employees Retirement System, paid holidays, vacation, personal days, accrued sick pay, and longevity.

Applications may be obtained at Heath City Hall, 1287 Hebron Rd. Heath, Ohio 43056, Monday – Friday 8:30 am – 4:30 p.m. or on our web site www.heathohio.gov. The application must be completed and returned to the same address along with copies of valid Ohio Driver's License and any relevant certifications no later than March 29, 2019 at 4:30 p.m.

Those wishing consideration for extra credit for military service must attach a copy of their DD214 Form to their application showing that they have been honorably discharged from military service and return with packet.
