

## **Utility Worker I – Water Distribution Examination**

The City of Heath Civil Service Commission will conduct an examination for a Utility Worker I – Water Distribution, on April 10 2018 at Hoback Park Shelter House, 60 Dorsey Mill Rd, Heath, Ohio, at 6:30 p.m.

Typical tasks include: assists with maintaining records, logs, and reports; assists with handling customer issues and concerns; assists with repair of water mains and distribution system; assists with purchases and inventory of equipment and supplies; assists with general housekeeping and maintenance of grounds and buildings within the utility department; may attend meetings, conferences and workshops to remain current with industries standards; can recommend needed equipment and repairs; carries out any other duties designated by the Utilities Director, Utility Worker III.

Employment standards for this position include: must be a high school graduate or equivalent; have the ability to work well with fellow employees; must be able to possess a valid Ohio CDL B – general, air brake and tank within six months of hire; should be aware of public health needs; should be aware of occupational hazards involved and the necessary precautions required; could possess a State of Ohio Class I or II Distribution, Water Certification; may require exposure to chemicals, solvents, pesticides and air borne pathogens; must have Ohio EPA Class I Certification within two years of hire.

Salary range is \$32,159.00 - \$35,116.01. The City of Heath offers a competitive benefit package.

Those wishing consideration for extra credit for military service must attach a copy of their DD214 Form to their application showing that they have been honorably discharged from military service and return with packet.
